requirements/eligibility

- Available to serve the Spring 2017 semester
- One semester completed within one's respective program (waived for Ph.D. applicants)
- Must be enrolled as a degree seeking student
- Minumim 3.2 GPA
- Must attend monthly ambassador meetings (tentatively scheduled for 2/3, 3/3, and 4/28 at 9:30 a.m)
- Must assist with 4 events, and 3 other activities each semester
- Must sign a media release

how to apply timeline
