

MSW Traditional Part Time Clinical Program – Jacksonville

For students who qualify for admission to the MSW Traditional program, classes for the clinical concentration may be taken in the part time format in Jacksonville, Florida. Each semester the program offers two courses that meet for three weekends each. The weekend format is Friday 6-9, Saturday 9-5, and Sunday 9-2. Both the generalist and advanced clinical field placements can be completed over two semesters in a part time format. It typically takes a student nine semesters or three years to complete the 61 credit hour program.

The clinical concentration curriculum enables students to meet the following objectives:

1. Assess, diagnose, and treat clients' psychosocial problems through individual, couple, family, and/or group modalities.
2. Facilitate clients gaining access to appropriate community resources.
3. Work cooperatively and/or collaboratively with other human service professionals to plan and implement services to clients.
4. Conduct empirical evaluations of their own practice interventions.
