Ph.D. Program Full Time Tallahassee Only

For students who qualify for admission to the Ph.D. program, the first year of the program, students learn the foundations for excellence in research. During this time, students develop a substantive area of interest, and their second year of coursework focuses on applying their learning to this individualized area of interest. Students' experience also includes a research practicum, a teaching practicum, and an integrative seminar that assists them in preparing their proposals for dissertation work. Throughout this program, students typically collaborate with faculty and their student colleagues on conference presentations and journal publications of their work; community, college, and university activities that promote social work values and leadership; and the opportunity to teach independently before they graduate.
