Focuses on the relationship between human behavior and social environments.

SOW 5404 Introduction to Social Work Research

Introduction to qualitative and quantitative methods. Helps students to develop, use, and communicate empirically based knowledge.

Discusses the importance of program evaluation and applied research methods.
